### Logline:

Blending elements of futuristic, fantasy, science fiction, and the paranormal, the Samsara Chronicles explores the duality of good and evil set against two worlds, Earth and Nirvana.

Guided by mystical beings, a human mother bears a daughter of alien royalty, Aislinn, destined to champion the future of Earth.

### Synopsis:

Samsara is a science fiction/fantasy/romantic action/thriller chronicling the battle between a human/alien hybrid to save a post-apocalyptic Earth and rescue her royal parents held captive on a dying, hostile world.

In the days before Earth is plunged into an apocalyptic future, Seanna Soule bears a daughter through supernatural intervention. Twenty-six years later, Aislinn Soule, daughter of alien royalty, meets and falls in love with her destined soulmate, Dylan Young.

Recognizing each other from their previous lives on their homeworld of Nirvana, their memories become visions of the enormous task ahead of them. Together, they must lead the salvation of Earth against multiple threats — the Eletarii, alien invaders converting willing humans into minions known as the Elementals, and the chameleon virus, a genetically targeted disease designed to cull millions.

Assisted by a mystical crystal skull, human and spirit animal guides, and the Antiquitas, ancient and powerful entities connected to Aislinn's heritage, she and Dylan embark on a perilous journey to Emerald Lake, British Columbia, to open a celestial portal by midnight on December 31.
